13	WHEREAS, AS29.60.450 requires that for a municipality to participate in the FY18 Shared Fisheries
14	Business Tax Program, the municipality must demonstrate to the Department of Commerce, Community,
15	and Economic Development that the municipality suffered significant effects during calendar year 2016
16	from fisheries business activities; and,
17	
18	WHEREAS, 3 AAC 134.060 provides for the allocation of available program funding to eligible
19	municipalities located within fisheries management areas specified by the Department of
20	Commerce, Community, and Economic Development; and,
21	
22	WHEREAS, 3 AAC 134.070 provides for the use, at the discretion of the Department of
23	Commerce, Community, and Economic Development, of alternative allocation methods which
24	may be used within fisheries management areas if all eligible municipalities within the area agree
25	to use the method, and the method incorporates some measure of the relative significant effect of
26 27	fisheries business activity on the respective municipalities in the area; and,
28	WHEREAS, The City and Borough of Sitka proposes to use an alternative allocation method for
29	allocation of FY18 funding available within the FMA 18: CENTRAL SOUTHEAST AREA in
30	agreement with all other municipalities in this area participating in the FY18 Shared Fisheries
31	Business Tax Program.

33	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The City and Borough of Sitka by this
34	resolution certifies that the following alternative allocation method fairly represents the
35	distribution of significant effects during 2016 of fisheries business activity in FMA 18:
36	CENTRAL SOUTHEAST AREA:
37	
38	All municipalities share equally 50% of allocation; all municipalities share remaining 50%
39	on a per capita basis.
