COVID-19 Positive Employee at NSRAA

On the morning of Friday, June 12, 2020, Northern Southeast Regional Aquaculture Association, Inc. (NSRAA) was informed that an NSRAA employee had tested positive for COVID-19. This employee started to feel ill during the day at work on Tuesday, June 9. The employee left work mid-day on Tuesday in order to isolate from our workforce and was tested for COVID-19 on Tuesday, June 9. After receiving confirmation of the positive result, NSRAA immediately suspended all non-essential operations, notified and isolated all close contacts of the infected individual, and is now in the process of implementing additional screening of critical workers.

NSRAA is in communication with the State of Alaska Department of Public Health to minimize risk to our employees, our families, and the community of Sitka. As a critical infrastructure industry, NSRAA is following all current state issued health mandates and is following the NSRAA Essential Business Worker Plan that was submitted to the State of Alaska in March, as well as, additional plans submitted to the communities in which we operate. NSRAA will continue to monitor this development and will consult with the State and health professionals for additional recommendations as needed. In order to protect the privacy of our employees we will not be providing additional details regarding this individual case at this time.
