\* On Election Day, a paper jam occurred in both precinct tabulators. In precinct #1, the voter chose not to get a new ballot. The Precinct Chair placed the ballot in a secure location to be counted on October 7. In precinct #2, the jammed ballot was not counted. Another ballot was not counted due to ambiguous marks which the Canvass Board discovered during routine audit. The Canvass Board reprocessed all precinct #2 ballots twice through the tabulator, confirmed totals, which are presented above. There are no substantial changes to the unofficial results for the Municipal Regular Election posted on October 4, 2022.
