**MOTION FOR EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION TO DEFENDANT’S
RENEW MOTION FOR JUDGMENT ACQUITTAL**

VRA CERTIFICATION

COMES NOW, Defendant Jordan T. Schauwecker (“Jordan”), by and through his counsel of record, Bradly A. Carlson and Jessica Wakefield of Carlson Law Group, LLC, pursuant to Alaska R. Criminal 42(i), hereby moves this Honorable Court to consider on an expedited basis Jordan’s *Renewed Motion for Judgement Acquittal* filed simultaneously with this motion.

On May 22, 2026, Jordan was convicted by jury on Count V of the Indictment, Attempted Sexual Assault in the First Degree. He was acquitted of all other charges. After

the verdict, Jordan renewed his Motion for Judgment of Acquittal under Alaska R. Crim. P. 29(b) and requested that this Court vacate the jury's verdict on Count V and find him not guilty. After hearing oral arguments from Jordan and the State, the Court took the matter under advisement before requesting briefing on the Motion. Because a conviction of Attempted Sexual Assault in the First Degree requires mandatory remand pending sentencing, Jordan was taken into custody.

Jordan respectfully requests that this Court expedite consideration and render a decision on his Renewed Motion for Judgment of Acquittal by July 1, 2026. Jordan does not request expedited briefing. Expedited consideration is necessary because Jordan is currently in custody awaiting sentencing on the offense for which he requests that the Court enter an order of acquittal or, in the alternative, order a new trial. Jordan asserts in the underlying motion that there is insufficient evidence that he committed the crime of attempt. In his alternative request for a new trial, he further asserts that the verdict is against the weight of the evidence.

Prompt consideration of this motion is warranted because Jordan will remain in custody while it is pending. If the Court enters an Order of Acquittal, Jordan would be entitled to immediate release. Alternatively, if the Court were to grant his request for a new trial, he would be eligible for release on bail. Accordingly, any delay unnecessarily prolongs Jordan's detention.


